2.1.1. Application Zoom

Download or update to the latest version of *the Zoom app*. The *Zoom app* only works with Windows/Mac OS, it does not work with Linux operating systems or web browsers.

Note1: The option to select simultaneous interpretation is only accessible through the *Zoom* application, and not by simply accessing the meeting using a web browser.

N.B.2: In case of technical difficulties encountered during the meeting, it will be possible to ask questions in the "Chat" section of *Zoom* (for example: difficulty seeing the shared document, difficulty hearing the speaker, etc.).

2.1.2. Microphone e webcam

During the meeting, only speakers will be able to keep their microphones and webcam on. Everyone else will have to turn them off.

2.1.3. Access to simultaneous interpretation

Once the application is open, follow these steps:

1. click on the Globe icon at the bottom right of the "Interpretation" screen;
2. click on the desired listening language;
3. click on "Mute Original Audio" to hear only the interpreter.



6. HOW TO GET THERE

6.1. Airplane

From Nice-Côte d'Azur airport, it is possible to reach the Auditorium Rainier III (30 km):

- By train (estimated total time: 1 hour – estimated total cost: €6.80):
 - from the exit of the terminal, take the tram to Grand Arenas (one stop, the ticket is free), then cross on foot to enter the "Nice Saint-Augustin" station ;
 - then take the regional train towards Menton and get off at the "Monaco-Monte-Carlo" stop (30 minutes – €4.80), exit "La Condamine". Check train timetables: <https://www.voyages-sncf.com>
 - then go on foot or take bus n°1 towards "Saint Roman" and get off at the "Auditorium Rainier III" stop (10 minutes – €2). Check bus schedules: <https://www.cam.mc/horaires/0-1>
- By bus (estimated total time: 50 minutes – estimated total cost: €22):
 - take the shuttle bus Line 80 (ex110) Express towards "Monaco-Menton" and get off at the "Monaco Place d'Armes" stop (40 minutes – €20.50). Check the bus schedule: <http://www.niceairportexpress.com>
 - then take bus n°1 towards "Saint Roman" and get off at the "Auditorium Rainier III" stop (10 minutes – €2). Check bus schedules: <https://www.cam.mc/horaires/0-1>
- By taxi (estimated total time: 45 minutes – estimated total cost: €100): +33 (0)4 93 13 78 78
